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## 7. COVID 19 Reminder

- a. Recently, there have been report cases of COVID - 19 from the St. Joseph International School, nearby to Honsbridge. School is asking every student and parent to take extra precaution to avoid crowded area and rest at home if having flu, cough and sore throat.
- b. If you have parents or members of family who have returned from overseas E.g. SINGAPORE, Japan, Korea, China, Italy or Hong Kong, it is possible that they are carrier of the virus, if students are in contact in such a case, the school requires student not come to school for at least 14 days.
- c. Students, staff and parents should also be informed how the virus has been transmitted to others who did not visit overseas. In the case of ST Johns International School and other reported cases in Malaysia. The transmission of the virus took place when one member of family has returned from overseas and is a carrier of the virus, he/she quarantines self at home with other family members. The carrier transmitted the virus to other family members who have been in contact with the carrier.
- d. It is possible that a carrier of COVID-19 takes more than 14 days to show symptoms of illness. Hence, if you know of anyone who is unwell, he/she should be wearing a mask and get well first.
- e. Please wash your hand regularly and do not touch your face.
