## **Unique Attributes:**

- 1. Small class size with a maximum of 20 students for Year 7 to 11 with 26 consecutive graduating batches of outstanding Cambridge IGCSE results since 2010. (2010-2022)
- 2. A strong sense of community that makes it easy to make friends and develop social skills.
- 3. Practical Science classes designed to create an interest in science as well as prepare students for the Checkpoint Exam.
- 4. Every student will have a chance to take up a leadership role and develop teamwork skills (e.g. Monitor, Prefect, Student Council, Mentor / Mentee program, Sports Committee etc).

## 1) TFK Scholarship

- Students from Year 7 to 11 who have achieved 80% and above in all subjects (average calculated across exams, homework and other assignments) are eligible to apply for the TFK scholarship.
- Under this scholarship they will be entitled to a RM500 rebate on academic fees for the next term of study.
  - This scholarship is applicable for one term of study and students may reapply for this scholarship for the next term.

## 2) Sibling Discount

- The second and subsequent siblings will enjoy a 10% discount on the academic fees for each term.
- In the case of another ongoing promotional discount or rebate, only
  one will be applied.



- The Referee will be entitled to RM300 under this programme and the referred party will also get RM300.
- This may be applied in the form of a rebate on tuition fees.
  Incentives are payable once registration fees, deposit, and one full terms tuition fees has been paid.
- The referred party must inform Honsbridge of their referee during the initial enquiry or first visit to be eligible for this incentive.
